The A.C.E. Student Convention dress standards require the young ladies to wear culottes for athletic events. Please refer to the following information *before* purchasing or sewing culottes for your students.

What do ISC-approved culottes look like?



Box-pleat culottes

(1611Skirts.com)



Pleated culottes

(pleats front and back)



Skirlots

(knee-length culottes with front and back knee-length panels attached to waistband, covering to the side seams)

(not ready made)

What do NOT meet ISC Guidelines for culottes?

- Loose-fitting knee-length basketball shorts
- Gauchos (no pleats or panels)
